Why Solar Energy Matters Now

Crunching the Numbers

Let's get real--what's the actual cost? A typical 5kW Enmax solar power system runs about \$15,000 pre-rebates. But factor in:

\$4,000 federal grant

\$1/m² municipal tax break

4.8¢/kWh micro-generation credits

Suddenly that 12-year payback period shrinks to 6-8 years. And with panels lasting 30+ years? That's 22 years of nearly free electricity--kind of like locking in 1990s energy prices forever.
