Sullivan's team just installed a 26.4 kWh Tesla Powerwall cluster in La Jolla - enough to power a 4-bedroom home through 3 blackout days. With SDG&E's new dynamic pricing, these systems earn \$1,200/year just by automatically discharging during 4-9 PM peaks.

Cutting Through San Diego's Red Tape

Did you know? The average solar permit here takes 34 days - unless you know the shortcuts. Sullivan's permit expeditors (they've got 3 dedicated to SD County) use a little-known "over-the-counter" process for 70% of



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residential jobs. That shaves 3 weeks off wait times compared to DIY applications.
